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DAY 1 (Sun., Sep. 6) – ARRIVAL TO KODIAK, ALASKA

After arriving to Kodiak this afternoon, you'll settle into your cozy lodging. Kodiak's downtown area and harbor are just a short stroll away, offering the perfect opportunity to wander and catch glimpses of bald eagles, sea otters, and sea lions—your new wild neighbors! Later, we'll gather for a warm and welcoming group dinner, where we'll enjoy some delicious local fare and craft brews as we toast to new adventures. Every night, we'll monitor the aurora forecast, hoping for clear skies to catch a glimpse of the northern lights.

Our day-long cruise takes us on a scenic route, where we'll be on the lookout for whales, sea otters, sea lions, puffins, and with any luck, world-famous Kodiak bears along the shoreline. Boxed lunches, snacks, and beverages will be provided to keep everyone energized.

After a full day on the water, we'll return to our lodging to rest and regroup. We'll check the aurora forecast and keep our fingers crossed for northern lights!
